To subscribe, send a plaintext (not html or rtf) e-mail message to listserv@ieee.org with the following text in the message body:

```
subscribe stds-p1619 Your Name
```

Substitute 'Your Name' with the name you would like to appear on the e-mail subscription. If you want to subscribe anonymously, use 'Anonymous' as your name
